# REENTRY ACTION PLAN AND RETURN SERVICE AGREEMENT

(Local Scholarship)

### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

In line with CHED Memorandum Order No. 3, series of 2016, and for and in consideration of the actualfinancial support for the duration of the scholarship benefits which will be released to the NOMINEE contingentupon his/her acceptance to the GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP FOR FACULTY AND STAFF UNDER THECHED K TO 12 TRANSITION PROGRAM and the DHEI, the SHEI shall allow the NOMINEE to pursue studieson a full-time basis leading to **Doctor of Philosophy in Mathematics** at the **MSU Iligan Institute of Technology** for a duration of 8 Semester(s)/Trimester(s)/Quarter(s)commencing on Second Semester AY 2016-2017 subject to the following terms and conditions:

# A. Obligations of the SHEI
