

## International Women's Day Celebration at SSCT LRC and SSCT Gymnasium on March 5, 2021.

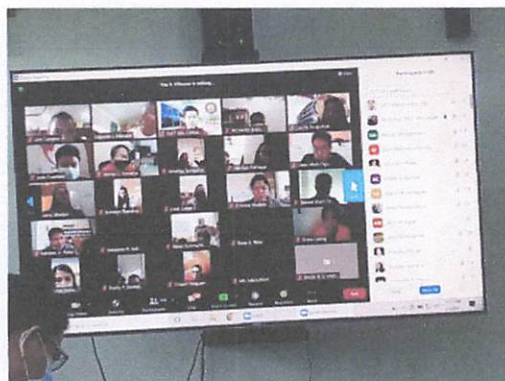
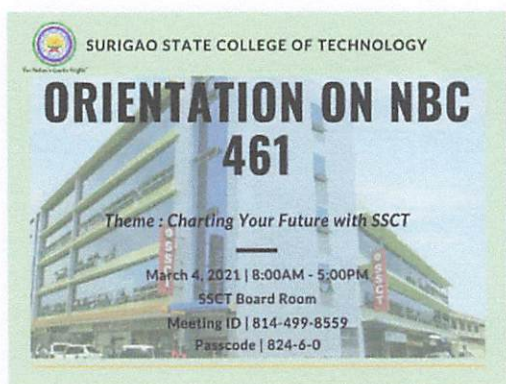

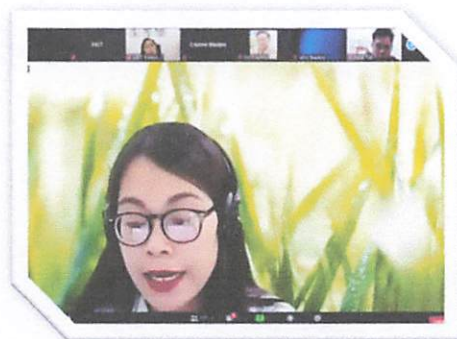
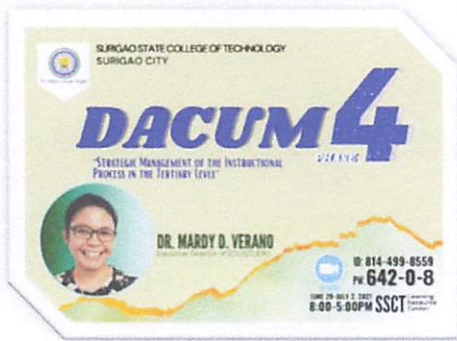
## Zoom Webinar on Quality Assessment for Outcome-based Education at SSCT Learning Resource Center on January 5-8, 2021.

The DACUM Phase 4 was the last phase of the 11-Day DACUM Webinar and Workshop Series.



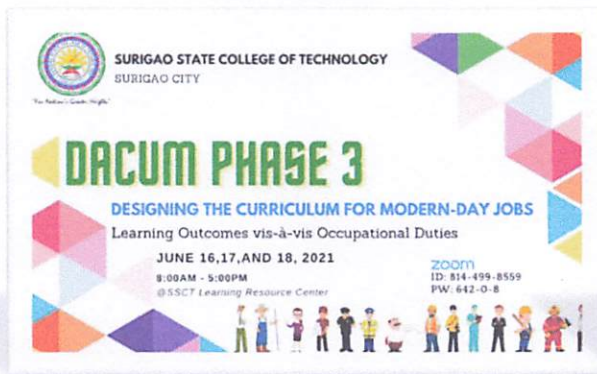


### SSCT's 50<sup>th</sup> Graduation Exercise AY 2019-2020 on July 3, 2021

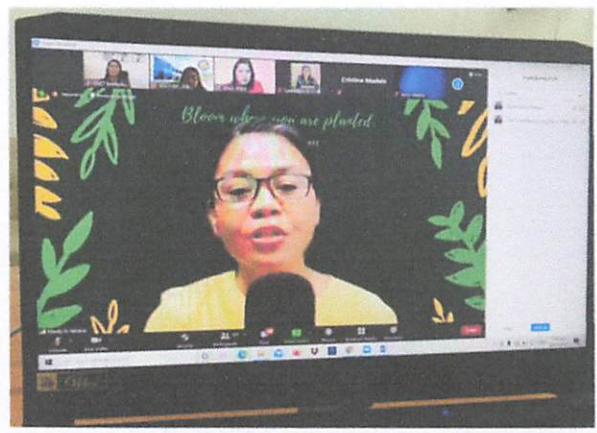
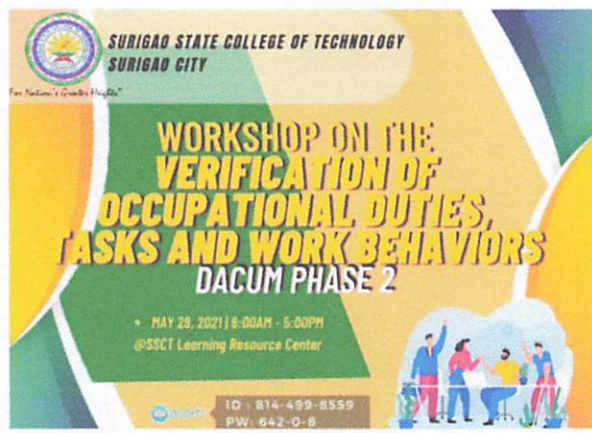

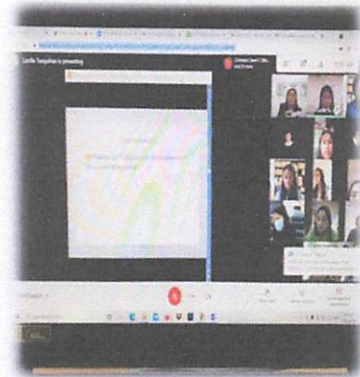




**Workshop on the Verification of Occupational Duties, Tasks and Work Behaviors DACUM PHASE 2 on May 28, 2021**

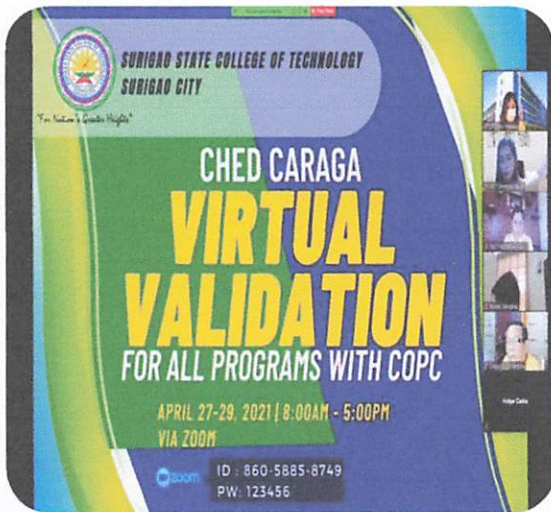
### **Virtual Class Observation on May 26, 2021**

**CHED Caraga Virtual Validation for all Programs with COPC on April 27-29, 2021**

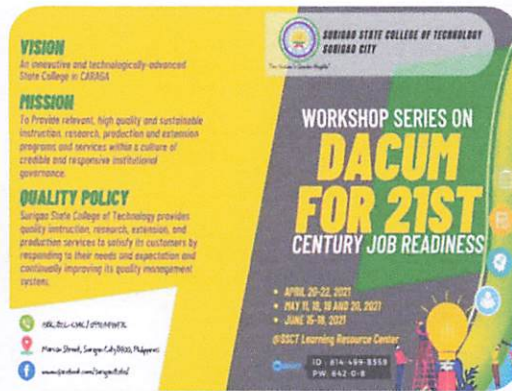
